

LOCAL RULES

PLAYER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

All players (i.e. members) are to check-in at the reception desk before play. It is player's responsibility to maintain good pace of play and keep the distance with group ahead. Players are obliged during their play to maintain the golf course by replacement of divots to their original position, to repair pitch-marks on the greens and when leaving bunkers to return them to the original condition. Play with practice balls or with more than one ball is strictly prohibited. Dress code do not accept players wearing jeans, army cloths, or shirts with no collar or sleeves.

If slow play occurs (gap more than one empty hole ahead) players have to follow marshal's instructions.

Marshal is obliged to first inform player about spotted breach of rules. Players have to realize that repeated negligence of before mentioned actions will be considered as gross breach of ethics as well as of the local rules and players can be penalized and would have to leave the golf course.

PACE OF PLAY POLICIES

It is recommended to apply "Ready Golf". Please follow the pace of play on Score Card or Timing sheet. When group is "out of position" the group must play "Ready Golf". Group is "out of position" when it is over the allocated time for the holes that have been played and not in position with the following group. Maximum Allowable Time 4:40.

PROVISIONAL BALL

Players shall be obliged when playing into forest or higher rough to play a provision ball from the original place.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (16-1)

All obstructions permanently installed on the golf course: houses, information boards on tees as well as all paved paths and gravel paths on the course, if artificially-surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which relief is allowed under Rule 16.1

MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (15.2)

Stakes determining penalty areas, ground under repair, distance markers, baskets, ball-cleaners, rakes, banks, directional and information boards (not built in).

INTEGRAL PART OF THE GOLF COURSE

Continuous shrubs represent an integral part of the golf course and play from such place shall continue with no relief. Any car path except paved path.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR (16-1)

A zone determined by blue stakes or white lines. If this zone is not located in a water hazard, players must take relief with no penalty and to continue according to the Rule 16-1. Relief is related to ball position, stance and space for the intended swing.

LIMITED RELIEF FOR EMBEDDED BALL

Free relief is not allowed when a ball is embedded in soil faces above bunkers.

USE OF ELECTRIC GOLF CARTS

During tournaments a player asking to use an e-car have to present a recommendation from a doctor. For all e-car users, it is strictly prohibited to drive through forest, roughs, greens, approaches and tees. It is allowed to drive through low-cut parts (except - greens, approaches, tees), paved paths and gravel paths.

OUT - DEFINING BOUNDARIES

A ball is out of bounds when it is beyond any fence defining the boundary of the course. On hole 18 is the out of bounds defining by wall of the clubhouse on the edge of the yellow penalty area.
